Our Mission: Fundraise for the Elderly

Our vision is to ensure a quality of life for the elderly now and to the end of life. Langley Care Foundation is a registered charity that raises funds to benefit the residents of Langley Lodge.

Funds raised by the Foundation have been used to purchase equipment for residential care, such as ceiling lifts, and, to provide staff hours for delivering a range of therapeutic programs such as music therapy, horticulture and pastoral care.

How your gift helps Langley Lodge Residents

Langley Lodge is owned, operated and maintained by Langley Care Society, a not-for-profit organization established in 1974. While the Lodge receives funding through Fraser Health, much of those funds are allocated for basic care only.

Langley Care Foundation is a registered charity established to benefit the residents of Langley Lodge and periodically, makes contributions to other not-for-profit organizations in Langley whose mandate is to support the elderly.

Donations to the Foundation influence the frequency of Pastoral Care, Art, Horticulture and Music Therapies scheduled for residents at Langley Lodge. These important therapeutic programs are not possible without support from the community. For example, in 2016 over 2,000 hours of programming were provided. Many capital purchases are reliant on gifts: dining room tables; hygienic slings; blanket warming cabinets; portable bladder scanner.
